What We Do

We offer assessment in the areas of ability, achievement, performance, and emotional-behavioural issues for children, youth, and adults. The typical process involves an initial session during which the reasons for the referral are clarified and background information is requested., followed by the actual testing.

The test data is then scored, analyzed and interpreted . After a report has been written, a final session (about one hour) is used to debrief the client(s) and provide copies of the report.

The outcomes of these assessments may include recommendations related to home/school/work strategies, modified/realistic expectations, adaptations/supports, referral for counselling/therapy, and/or referral for medical/neurological/psychiatric assessment or intervention. My approach is to make sense of the student by discerning the themes that are evident in the history and the assessment.

Tests of Overall Cognitive Ability Wechsler Intelligence Scale for Children-Fourth Edition (WISC-IV, ages 6-16) currently being replaced with WISC-V Wechsler Adult Intelligence Scale -Fourth Edition (WAIS-IV, ages 16+)

Tests of Academic Achievement Wechsler Fundamentals: Academic Skills (WF:AS)
Wechsler Individual Achievement Test-Third Edition (WIAT-III)

Tests for Emotional-Behavioural Issues
Conners 3rd Edition (Conners 3)
The Conners 3 provides a checklist format through which teachers and parents can identify attentional and behavioural problems in children

Behaviour Assessment System for Children Second Edition (BASC-III)
The BASC-III uses a multidimensional approach to evaluate the behaviour and self-perceptions of children

Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders - Fifth Edition (DSM-5)
Screening for disorders as per diagnostic criteria of the American Psychiatric Association

Test of Adaptive Function
Adaptive Behaviour Assessment System – Second Edition (ABAS-II)
-complete assessment of adaptive skills

FEE STRUCTURE

It is assumed that a Cognitive-Learning (WISC-IV/WAIS-IV & WF:AS or WIAT-III) Assessment requires 10 hours overall while an Emotional-Behavioural Assessment (BASC-3 and/or Conners 3, and also includes a Cognitive-Learning Assessment as above) will take 12 hours overall.

- CONNERS-3 (\$300-\$400)
- ABAS-II (\$300-\$400)
- CONSULTATIONS WITH PARENTS (\$150/hr, \$100/hr – current FBCS students)
