

GRADE 3 MATH AND SCIENCE UPDATES FOR THE WEEK OF JUNE 03, 2019

MATH: We are learning about polygons, elements of geometry, congruent and non-congruent shapes and symmetry. Students completed their last assessment in multiplication and division which I should be finished marking by Tuesday. Our last Math unit is on Capacity which we will start by Wednesday.

SCIENCE:

Students went on a field trip to Cayman water to look at how water is purified. They then made posters in class to show the processes involved and what they learnt from the trip. A revision sheet for the unit on Water was given on Friday 7 June. See below for test dates.
