

#### **LESSON 1: CODING**

What will I be learning about?	This lesson introduces you to <b>while</b> loops and <b>if / else</b> statements. While loops are loops that continue to repeat commands as long as a condition is true. While loops are used when the programmer doesn't know the exact number of times the commands need to be repeated, but the programmer does know what condition needs to be true in order for the loop to continue looping. <b>If / Else</b> statements offer flexibility in programming by running entire sections of code only if something is true, otherwise it runs something else.
Vocabulary	<ul> <li>Condition - A statement that a program checks to see if it is true or false. If true, an action is taken. Otherwise, the action is ignored.</li> <li>Conditionals - Statements that only run under certain conditions.</li> <li>While Loop - A loop that continues to repeat while a condition is true.</li> </ul>
