Place value can be defined as the value represented by a digit in a number on the basis of its position in the number. Place value columns to the right of the decimal point are decimals and part of a whole. We will be learning about tenths, hundredths and thousandths. We can represent decimals as a fraction. When we compare numbers, we must compare each place value of both numbers.
