To be able to write decimals in a variety of forms. (Standard, written and expanded form)	 STANDARD, WRITTEN AND EXPANDED FORM The standard form of a decimal number shows the decimal number written in figures. As an example, two tenth is written as 0.2 in standard form. When writing decimals that have a zero in the ones place, like 0.2 or 0.017, don't write "point," "and" or anything else. Just start writing the number. For example, write 0.9 as nine tenths, whereas 1.9 is one and nine tenths. When you write a number in expanded form (also known as expanded notation), you are expressing the number separated into its composite individual place values (and decimal values if necessary) in the form of an expression.
