To be able to round decimals to the nearest whole number.	ROUNDING DECIMALS TO THE NEAREST WHOLE NUMBER: - Look at the tenths digit (the digit after the decimal point). - if it is less than 5 then round the number down by removing the decimal part of the number; - if it is 5 or more then round the number up by adding one on to the ones digit and removing the decimal part of the number. - Examples: - 3.8 rounds up to 4 because the tenths digit is an 8. - 6.29 rounds down to 6 because the tenths digit is a 2. - 12.527 rounds up to 13 because the tenths digit is a 5.
