Students will: <ul> <li>Identify adverbs in sentences</li> <li>Recognize whether an adverb tells how, when, or where about the verb</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Unit 7.1 - What Is an Adverb?</li> <li>ACTIVITY 1: <ul> <li>Watch Introduction to Adverbs video: https://youtu.be/94aFcx6oliY</li> <li>In this video, you'll learn all about adverbs! You will be able to answer the question: "What is an adverb?" You will be able to find adverbs in a sentence! And you will be able to add adverbs to a sentence to make it more detailed and interesting!</li> <li>Adverbs are a kind of modifier that you can use to change verbs or adjectives, like 'very' or 'carefully'.</li> <li>Adverbs tell HOW, WHEN, and WHERE.</li> <li>Example: Grayson ran SLOWLY.</li> <li>How did Grayson run? He ran SLOWLY. Slowly is the adverb.</li> <li>THEN I sealed the envelope.</li> <li>When did I seal the envelope? THEN. Then is the adverb.</li> <li>All the shoes were UPSTAIRS.</li> <li>Where were the shoes? UPSTAIRS.
